

KEOSAUQUA CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING

June 19th, 2020 - 4:00 P.M.

Council met in a Special Session with the following Council members present: Carol Harlan, Twyla Peacock, Josh Cocherell, Gary Kingsbury and Larry Shipley. Others present: Sandra Polonsky, Maggie Cocherell, Kelly Loeffler, Jake Poling and Jon Thornsberry

Mayor Hranicka opened the meeting at 4:00 PM.

Motion Shipley, seconded Kingsbury to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

City Superintendent's Report:

Superintendent Jake Poling informed the Council that, after talking with a pool company, it looks like we will be able to operate the pool this season if a couple of repair issues can get fixed. In addition to the discussion on the repairs, the Council discussed operating under the current CDC COVID-19 guidelines for pools.

New Business:

Motion Peacock, seconded Shipley to approve the following:

- City Superintendent to complete the necessary repairs on the pool in order to operate this summer. The pool will open as soon as the repairs, lifeguards and all operations are prepared.
- Jon Thornsberry to hire the lifeguards and a head lifeguard for the 2020 pool season.
- Offer only pre-packaged food at the pool concession stand.
- Operate the pool between the hours of 12pm – 7pm, depending on lifeguard availability.
- Private swim lessons offered outside of pool hours as much as possible.
- Admission prices to remain the same.
- Park and Rec committee to work out all other operational details regarding the pool with City staff.

Motion carried 5-0.

Motion Shipley, seconded Kingsbury to adjourn at 5:10 PM. Motion carried 5-0.
